Stirling played 80 Tests for the Wallabies (29 as Captain) and has 143 Super Rugby Caps. He scored 489 Test Points, was the fastest Wallaby to reach 50 & 100 test points and also the first player to reach 1000 super points. On 26 January 2012, Stirling was awarded Member of the Order of Australia (AM) for service to rugby, particularly as Captain of the Wallabies.
